The candidates who were not appointed were thanked very sincerely and encouraged to join the Friends of BHPC. The group of interested people called the Friends are willing to help accomplish the Commission's goals.

The remainder of the agenda was postponed until our regular meeting on the 26th of June. Included on the June 26th agenda will be the budget.
