Chief's Monthly Report-November 2024

Department News

Police Department reported an increase of crime for the month of October and this trend continued into the beginning of November. At this time, while the investigation is still ongoing and limited details can be released; the Department is happy to share that through intelligence gathered by patrol officers, investigators, and networking with surrounding law enforcement, a search warrant for the Operation of a Stolen Vehicle Processing Facility was executed November 12th on a local residence leading to multiple arrests and the recovery of stolen items and vehicles. These recovered items were connected to cases of thefts and the commission of other felonies in Blanco and surrounding counties.

The State system which provides driver's license and vehicle registration information—which is crucial for conducting safe and successful traffic stops—was unable to be accessed by officers or Dispatch due to the system antenna located at the Law Enforcement Center in Johnson City sustaining catastrophic damage. This system was out of service for over a week in November; affecting the number of traffic stops conducted by patrol officers this month.

Community Events & Involvement

The Police Department at the direction of Chief Thornhill worked with establishments within the community to coordinate a Thanksgiving Food Drive benefiting the Good Sam here in Blanco. Thanks to the outpouring of support from the community, the drive had to be cut short as so much food was collected the Good Sam ran out of space.

Staffing

The month of November, the Police Department saw an increase of full-time staffing by one patrol officer.

Chris Griffin, a 10 year-police veteran, was selected from out of three candidates who applied with our department in the month of October and began his field training this month.

The Police Department continues to recruit qualified applicants to fill one open patrol position, for which one application has been received and is in background.

Angel Vallejo (sponsored cadet) is continuing his studies through the AACOG Police Academy.

Milton Saltmarsh completed the required courses to sit for the TCOLE exam and will challenge the test in the beginning of December 2024.

Summary

During the month of November 2024, the Blanco Police Department saw another increase in providing officer assistance to other agencies as well as an increase in arrests; despite still being understaffed. The increase in arrests indicates not necessarily an increase in any crime trend, but more so increased effort in searching for suspicious and wanted persons following the reported increase in vehicle and property thefts in October 2024. The Police Department will continue to closely monitor data to determine if these crime trends change, and if new ones appear to develop.
